

Using Humanoid Robots to Improve Social Behaviors of Children with Autism



Are you worried about the social skills of your children?

This 6-month study examines the use of humanoid robots at improving social skills such as eye gaze attention and facial expressions of children with ASD.

Children are eligible if they:

- Are between 7-17 years
- Have diagnosed with High Functioning Autism or Pervasive Developmental Disorder-Not Otherwise Specified (PDD-NOS)

Participants will do the following experiments:

- 1. Play with Robot
- 2. Facial Expressions Imitation
- 3. Joint Attention
- 4. Communicative Skill Training

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
